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Case Summary

I was dispatched to the above residence for an unattended death. I was told that the deceased was a 14 YOA male and that he was a member of the Followers of Christ Church. When I arrived I met with the parents, Dan and Sally Sevy, who told me that their son had been ill for about 2 weeks. They stated that he had been coughing and running a low grade temperature during this time. The mother stated that around Friday or Saturday he began having difficulty breathing and had a severe rattle in his chest. He was still eating and drinking fluids but that he never seemed to get better. As time went on he began having more shortness of breath and the rattle in his chest got worse. She stated that on this evening she was holding him on her lap when he died. The church members then gathered and after ministering to him, they called for the coroner. On exam I found him to be pale and cool to the touch. There were no signs of trauma.
